At the in-class seminar that will take place on October 26-28 in the Liberale Jewish Community Beth Shalom Munich, we will deepen our understanding of the concept, will analyze its practical implications and will discuss concrete strategies and dilemmas of actively engaging volunteers into community life.

Participants will also get an update on important topics of community administration!
